What is this product?

Objectives

The Fund aims to provide a combination of capital growth and income based on exposure to optimal income streams in investment markets, while applying ESG Criteria.

Core investment: the Fund typically invests directly in a mix of assets within the following investment limits:

- at least 50% in fixed income securities (including bonds and asset-backed securities);
- up to 20% in company shares.

The Fund invests in bonds issued by governments, government-related institutions and companies from anywhere in the world, including emerging markets. These bonds can be denominated in any currency. The Fund may invest in bonds of any credit quality, including up to 100% in lower quality bonds. A minimum of 80% of the fund will be invested in assets denominated in euro or in other currencies hedged back to euro. The Fund invests in securities that meet the ESG Criteria, applying an Exclusionary Approach as described in the precontractual annex.

Other investments: the Fund may invest up to 20% in asset-backed securities, up to 20% in contingent convertible debt securities, in other funds, and up to 50% in cash (meaning eligible deposits) and assets that can be turned quickly into cash.

Derivatives usage: for investment purposes and to reduce risk and cost.

Strategy in brief:

- Investment approach: the Fund is a flexible global bond fund. The investment manager selects investments based on an assessment of macroeconomic, asset, sector and stock-level factors. Spreading investments across issuers and industries is an essential element of the Fund's strategy. In seeking an optimal income stream from investments, the investment manager may invest in a company's shares if they present a more attractive investment opportunity relative to its bonds.
- Investment manager's ESG classification: Planet+ / ESG Enhanced, as defined in the Fund's prospectus.

Benchmark: A composite index comprising:

- 1/3 Bloomberg Global Aggregate Corporate Index EUR Hedged
- 1/3 Bloomberg Global High Yield Index EUR Hedged
- 1/3 Bloomberg Global Treasury Index EUR Hedged

The benchmark is a comparator used solely to measure the Fund's performance and reflects the scope of the Fund's investment policy but does not constrain portfolio construction. The Fund is actively managed. The Fund's holdings may deviate significantly from the benchmark's constituents.

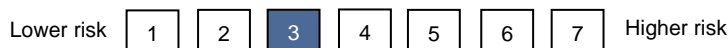
Intended retail investor

The Fund is for retail and institutional investors who want a combination of capital growth and income from a portfolio at least half of which is invested in debt securities.

The Fund is appropriate for investors with sustainability preferences. The return on your Fund is directly related to the value of its underlying assets, which is determined by the credit rating and the markets' view of the debt issuer, as well as reflecting broader economic and political themes. As an investor your capital is at risk. The value of your portfolio, and any income you may receive from it, can go down as well as up. You may get back less than you originally invested.

Risk Indicator



The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 5 years.

The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or because we are not able to pay you.

We have classified this product as 3 out of 7, which is a medium-low risk class.

This rates the potential losses from future performance at a medium-low level, and poor market conditions are unlikely to impact the capacity of M&G Luxembourg S.A. to pay you.
